We also could have a closer look at the VR tools created at our hosting company Virsabi.

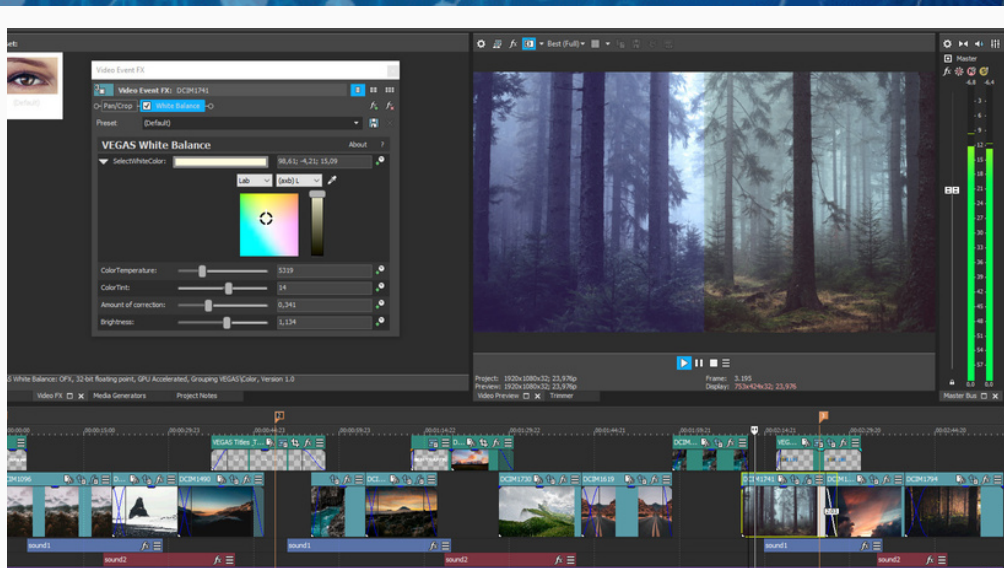
